
This was such a special gathering for the children, staff and parents and a beautiful way to start the school day. The children chose their hymns and sang wonderfully and read with such reverence.

This new system has been positively received by the Governing body and the Parent Partnership group, and we look forward to sharing the reports with you before the end of the Spring Term.

Rights Respecting Schools – The Global Learning Programme
