Each half term we will tell you about an aspect of the early years.

This time we are discussing continuous provision.

These areas are carefully thought out and offer opportunities for children to make choices, take risks, develop speaking and listening and enable them to use their imagination in a purposeful context.

Adults will often enhance this provision by adding resources which match the interests of the children in order to inspire, extend and challenge their learning.
