








For World Day of the Poor, children worked together to fill backpacks.

Cathedral links

Did you know:

- A number of cardinals as well as one saint (St John Southworth) are buried in the Cathedral.
- You can see the cardinals' hats which hang over the tombs until they fall. All the cardinals have hats over their tombs apart from Cardinal Cormac Murphy O' Connor.
- Cardinal Basil Hume is buried here. He devoted his life to the service of God and others.
- He set up the Cardinal Hume Centre alongside the Passage, another large charity in Westminster, which helps to bring Christ to the homeless and less fortunate.
