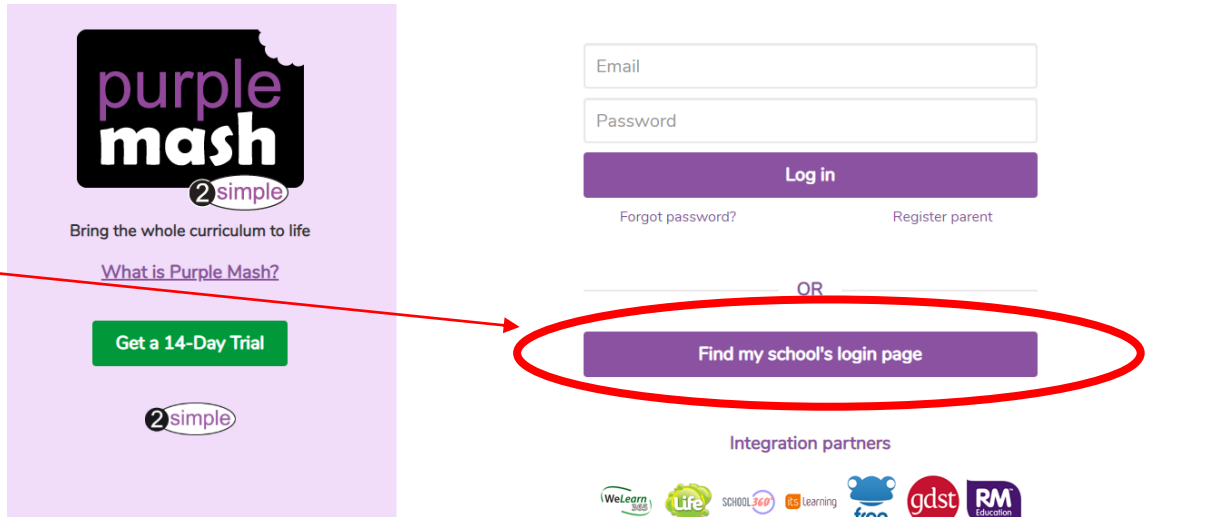

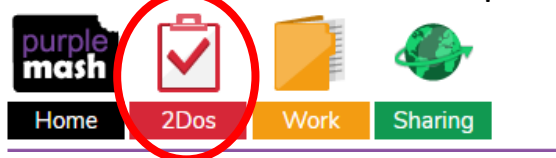

1. Click the '2Dos' tab in the top left hand corner.

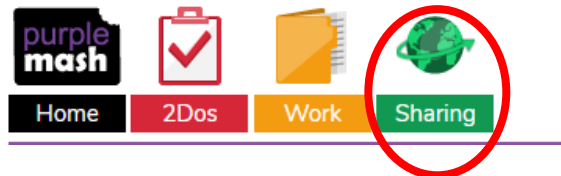

4. Once you have completed the task please remember to click 'Hand In'. The teachers can only see your hard work and provide feedback once you have done this.

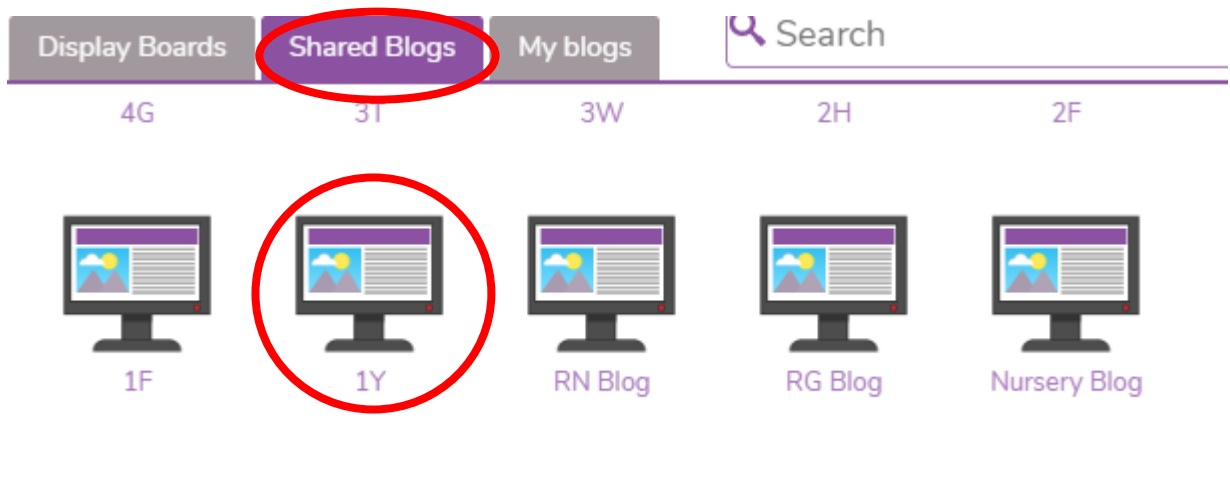


## How to add to your class blog

3. Click 'Shared Blogs' and then click on your class.



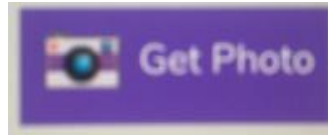
4. To add a post, click on the green button on the top right hand corner of the page.



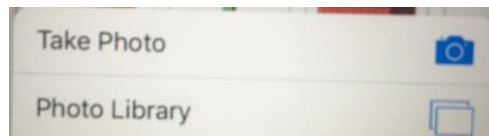

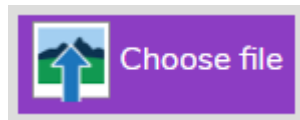
a. If using an Ipad:



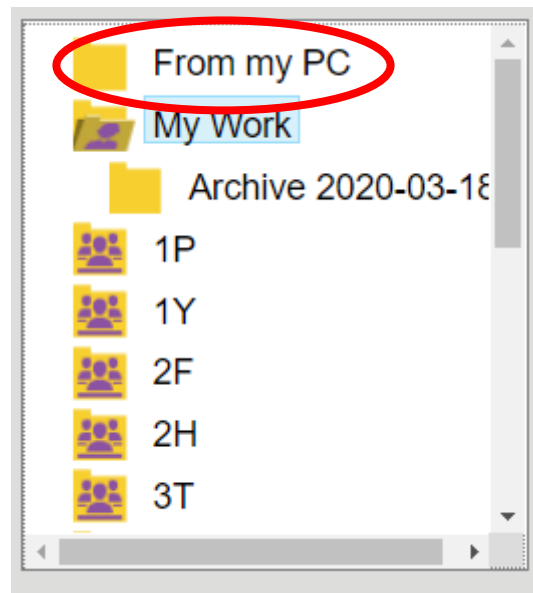
- i. Click
