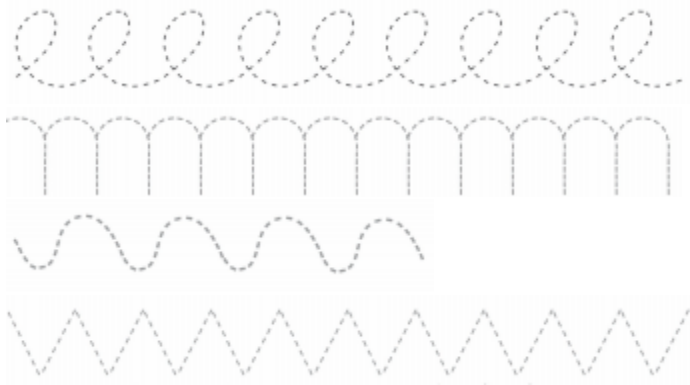


Handwriting Practise

Please pick appropriate tasks for your child. We are not expecting all of the children to progress through all of the stages below.

1. Practise their pencil control by making the patterns below:



2. Practise the formation of their letters in the family groups as shown below (only one or two letters at a time):

- a. c a d g o q
- b. l b h k t
- c. i j m n p r u y
- d. v w e f s x z

3. Once your child is correctly forming all of their letters using the lead in (ascender) and lead out (descender) strokes then move onto joined up handwriting. Practise their joined up handwriting by writing out some of the words from their year group spelling list.
4. Choose an extract of text or a piece of work they have typed up this week and write it up in their neatest handwriting.
