

Optional Daily Timetable for Learning in Key Stage 1

Please remember - this is a guide only- approx. 3-3.5 hours daily

Reading 15 mins daily	Read some of your book to an adult each day, this can be an online book or one from your home.
Phonics 15 mins daily	Recap phase 3 and phase 5 phonemes. You can do this by watching YouTube videos (Mr Thorne does Phonics), online games (phonics play) or playing games around your home, such as word hunts.
Literacy Tasks – 30 mins daily	There are five “2dos” on Purple Mash each week focusing on Literacy. Please work through these, taking note of your teacher’s feedback and redoing when asked.
Maths - 30 mins daily	There are five “2dos” on Purple Mash each week connected to maths. Please work through these, taking note of your teacher’s feedback and redoing when asked. In addition to these, it’s important to practise your number bonds (to every number up to 20), counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and for Year 2 only practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
Handwriting – 20 mins daily	The website has handwriting paper you can print if you wish, otherwise use paper you have at home. Follow the handwriting activities which are appropriate for your child on the school website (school closure section).
Physical Activity - 60 mins daily	PE with Joe Wicks (YouTube) Please follow Mr Reilly’s lesson ideas on your class blog Rising stars daily lunch time football programme. If you are able to, play in the garden or go out for a walk or cycle when permitted to do so.
French – 30 mins weekly	Please see the tasks set on the school closure page on the website by Madame Reeve
Foundation subjects - 30 mins daily	There are five 2dos set on purple mash each week for these areas, please work through these across the week, taking note of your teacher’s comments. When these are completed, choose activities from the topic grid on your year group page and post these on your class blog. The teachers would love to see them!
