This month is Barvember! It is a month to focus on bar modelling to support children in visualising and solving maths problems. Children in Years 1- Year 6 will be taking part in daily Bar Modelling problems each day

What is a bar model?

The bar model is a visual strategy to help solve number problems using different sized rectangles to represent numbers. The rectangles or 'bars' are proportional so that a larger number in a problem is represented by a larger bar. Sometimes calculations and word problems are difficult for children to visualise in their head and bar models help them to see the maths more clearly.


Sunday 8th November 2020
