### **Gate System**



Thank you so much for your co-operation with the gates in the morning. The drop off and pick up systems are running quickly and effectively especially in the mornings. Most year groups are all in within three minutes of the gates opening. So that the school day starts on time for all children please note the new registration time for each year group. (For parents who have numerous gates and drop off times please do not be alarmed. We know who you are- this will be taken into consideration)

## Registration



 To clarify - when being registered, the children need to be in their classrooms answering their teacher when their name is called in order to be marked present.

## Water Bottles, Book Bags and Swimming Kits, Packed Lunches

\* Please remember to send your child to school with everything they need. There have been an unusual number of parents coming to the school gate to drop off the above items. A final check before you leave home will help your child to be organised!

### **Office Staff & Communication**

- Please let the office staff know of any changes to pick up before 2:45pm so they have time to inform the class teachers.
- \* After 2:45pm the office staff will be on the road setting up the road closure barrier.

### When to isolate



- Please remember that if anyone in your home has
  COVID symptoms the children must isolate until the person with symptoms has a negative test.
- If someone in your home has tested positive for
  COVID your child must isolate for 14 days regardless if
  they receive a negative test within the 14 day period.

## How isolation works!

#### **Coronavirus Incubation timeline**

## It can take up to 14 days to develop symptoms after exposure - this is known as the incubation period.

#### DAY 0

Hannah was exposed to coronavirus.

#### DAY 5

Hannah got tested and was negative.

#### DAY 7

Thinking she didn't have coronavirus, Hannah attended school, and was in close contact with 17 people.

#### DAY 9

Hannah developed symptoms and tested positive. She was contagious for 48 hours before her symptoms started, and exposed 17 people to coronavirus. These 17 people now all need to self-isolate for 14 days.

This is why it's so important to self-isolate for the allocated time and to only book a test if you develop symptoms.
