We hope you are all keeping well. This email is an update of information relating to the office (rather than learning) for this week.

1. Mobile Data Government Upgrade Scheme

If you do not have a Broadband contract at home and are using mobile data for your child's learning, please read the attached information as there may be help available.

2. Reporting of Covid-19 Cases

The DfE have made it clear to schools that data on cases of Covid-19 among the student population still need to be reported by the school, even if the child is currently at home. Therefore we ask that you contact the school (phone or email is fine) if your child:

- is displaying any symptoms of Covid-19 infection
- has tested positive for Covid-19
- has been asked to isolate due to contact with a case outside the school setting.

When you contact us, please provide the child's name and class and the date either of the start of isolation, start of symptoms or positive test, whichever is appropriate.

3. Consultation on Chipping Barnet Community Plan

Chipping Barnet's Draft Community Plan consultation is now open. Members of the public have the opportunity to help shape a draft proposed vision for the town's Community Plan. We have been asked to share the link with our school community.
