Important Information

The additional Bank holiday which has been scheduled for 3 June 2022 to celebrate the Queens Platinum jubilee falls within our half term break. All schools have been asked by the DfE to reschedule an additional day during the year so that students and staff have the opportunity to mark the occasion. We have chosen Friday 1st July 2022 for our additional bank holiday. Please make a note of this in your diaries.

A reminder that any child who is displaying a covid symptom, ie a temperature, cough or loss of taste and smell, must stay at home and book a **PCR** test. Lateral Flow tests should not be used for anyone displaying any symptoms.

There has been a marked increase in dog ownership over lockdown and we are now seeing more dogs in the playground. We do not want to issue a blanket ban, but please could owners avoid bringing their dogs to the playground, and if unavoidable please carry or have your dog on a very short leash.

Year 3 - Zoo Lab Visit

On Wednesday afternoon, the Year 3 children participated in a Predator, Prey and Food Chains workshop. They saw a variety of animals such as stick insects, a giant snail and a snake. They learnt which of the animals were primary and secondary consumers and which were apex predators. As well as this, they considered which of the animals were herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. The children loved handling the animals and came away with an excellent knowledge of food chains.

Year 4 visit Verulamium Museum

As part of our 'I am Warrior' topic, year 4 had a wonderful time exploring the Verulamium museum in St Albans. We took part in a Roman artefact workshop which gave pupils the opportunity to handle, and learn more about, Roman tools, equipment and mosaics. We ended the day with a visit to the excavation site of an old Roman amphitheater where we were able to explore the ruins!

Year 2 trip to Shoeburyness

On Monday Year 2 had a wonderful time visiting the East Beach in Shoeburyness. The children absolutely loved combing the beach for living and non-living things and they greatly enjoyed working as a team to create sandcastles. They also took time to pause and reflect on what they could see, hear, touch and smell around them and we thought about exciting adjectives that we could use to describe the beach. Thank you again to all of our parent volunteers who helped us on the day.

Jeans for Genes Day

Today we celebrated 'Jeans for Genes Day' at St Catherine's. The children wore jeans to mark the occasion and we were able to raise money for an important cause.
