#### Welcome to Reception and Nursery children

This week we welcomed our final cohort of Reception and Nursery children to St Catherine's. We hope they have had a lovely start to St Catherine's School. We are incredibly lucky to have such wonderful families join the St Catherine's community.

#### **Covid Advice and Actions**

Since the summer the advice we receive from Public Health, the DfE and the LA has changed. Please ensure the following:

If your child is unwell: Do not send a sick child into school. If they have one of the 3 symptoms (cough, temperature, loss of taste or smell), you must book a PCR test and isolate them until the result comes back. If negative, they can return to school.

If a family member tests positive: ALL members of the household should take a PCR test and stay at home whilst awaiting the results. If the child's result is negative they can return to school, but please keep a distance from the positive case at home, monitor the child closely for symptoms and take daily lateral flow tests during the person's isolation period.

If a lateral flow test is positive: This must be followed up with a PCR test as soon as possible (within 2 days). The person should isolate whilst awaiting the result and if negative can return to school or if positive should isolate.

All positive cases from a PCR test will be contacted by Test and Trace and advised of the end of their isolation period.

We recommend that families take regular lateral flow tests twice a week, which are available free from any pharmacy.

The school is ensuring we are following all the current guidance and is working closely with Public Health England. We are unable to give out information about individual cases to other parents. We are being extremely vigilant and will continue to contact parents with up to date information if and when the number of cases in a class increases.
