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Colder weather



Children in Need



Online Safety - Location Settings

There are a number of apps which allow you to share your location such as Snapchat and Pokemon Go. It is recommended that unless needed, location settings are turned off for all apps that your children use. If they are left turned on, it could mean that your child's location or frequently visited locations are visible to strangers, putting them at risk. Apps where your child may need to have location services turned on include, mapping apps and also, for older children, apps that allow you to track your child's location if they were travelling home alone. It may be useful to have a conversation with your child about location settings as they may not be aware of them or aware of the potential risks they pose.
