

Changes to COVID-19 Testing

Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive lateral flow test result will be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January if you have no symptoms. This will mean that if your child receives a positive lateral flow test result they will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test unless they have symptoms, when they will still need to take a PCR. Due to the introduction of day 6 and 7 Lateral Flow Device testing, we thought it would be useful to share the following diagram.

We now have a subscription to 5-a-day Fitness which includes home access for your children. 5-a-day Fitness is the ultimate fun fitness resource aimed to increase your children's daily physical activity with our online 5-minute exercise routines, and 2-minute chill-out routines, helping to keep children active and healthy after school, at weekends, and over the holidays. Each activity routine enhances kinesthetic learning and utilises both audio and visual instructions and demonstrations. Online Safety

As a new chapter of Fortnite emerged in December, so did new potential risks for children. Fortnite has a PEGI age rating of 12, however many younger children have access to and use it. It is therefore vital that adults have an understanding of what they can do to keep their children safe if they are using it. National Online Safety have produced a newsletter explaining how you can keep your child safe if they do use Fortnite. They recommend things such as ensuring there is no payment method linked to the game's store so that no in-app purchases can be made. Also, reminding children not to click on any links which could be sent by scammers pretending to offer children free V-bucks.
