Personal Social and Emotional Development: This half term we will be focusing on getting to know the friends in our class, and building these relationships. We will continue to explore feelings, and following rules and routines. We will also be exploring what makes us different to other people. We will also act out stories and role play as characters from our key books. We will also prepare for our Christmas Nativity.
Understanding the World: This half term our RE focus is God's Family. We will be learning about and identifying different festivals and celebrations, including Bonfire Night, Diwali, and Hannukah. We will also be learning about God's Family, and how he chose Mary to be Jesus' mother. We will learn that Advent is a special time of the year, when we wait for Jesus's birth. We will also be closely observing the changing weather and season.	Physical Development: We will be developing our muscle tone and doing lots of fine and gross motor activities to develop our ability to put pencil pressure on paper. We will be using different tools to effect changes to materials, for example scissors, one handed holepunches, and stamps, and developing our preference for a dominant hand. We will also be focussing in outdoor PE on negotiating space and developing ball skills, for example throwing, catching and kicking different sized balls.		Communication and Language: We will be focusing on developing and broadening our vocabulary. We will focus on telling and retelling different stories. We will develop our book talk and share our ideas about books, characters, and settings. We will also be working on following instructions closely.
