Communication & Language (Prime) and Literacy.

- We will try and retell familiar stories such as 'The gingerbread man'.
- To sing familiar rhymes.
- We will develop phonological awareness and spot and suggest rhymes.
- Explore new vocabulary and use it in play.
- Continue Phase 1 Phonics
- Add marks to drawings and give meaning to the marks.
- Develop an awareness of syllables and alliteration.
- Beginning to be aware of the way that stories are structured with a beginning, middle and end.

Physical Development (Prime)

- We will try to be more independent when getting dressed and undressed, putting on our coats and doing up zips.
- Continue Funky Fingers activities
- Continue toileting routines
- Continue encouraging Healthy eating and trying new foods
- We will try and start to take part in some group activities and games.

Understanding the world

- Talk about pancake day and the start of lent.
- Prepare for Easter and spring time

- Continue to join in with routines and special events such as lent, Easter, St. Patricks day.

- We will begin to develop complex stories using small world equipment like animal sets, dolls, dolls houses.
- We will try to make imaginative and more complex small world using blocks, construction blocks/kits and material
- Continue to Explore music, sounds and sing songs
- Continue to use and explore the dressing up areas
- Enhancing home corner role play area with props, clothes and costumes for 'Goldilocks and the three bears.'
