Dear Parents,

We are delighted to have welcomed all our children to St Catherine's for this academic year. The last cohort of our nursery and reception children started with us this week.

Now that the St Catherine's family is complete it's really important that we do our bit so that our community can thrive and our children receive every opportunity to succeed.

With the help of the class reps drumming up support in Years 1 to 5 lets come together and be part of St Catherine's community and actively support our PTA and their fundraising events in our words (to each other or on social media) and in our actions.

I look forward to seeing many of you at the AGM on **1<sup>st</sup> November** and at the fundraising events we have already planned for this Autumn term!
